The Milwaukee battery powered angle grinder was bought from Midland Fixings Limited and paid for by donation being collected by Paul Bysh at his father's funeral.

Over six hundred pounds was donated to Donington Emergency Services Team with Jo Bysh, "Paul's uncle" being the major contributor.

Peter Bysh passed away in March of this year and worked as a records clerk for Bemrose in Spondon. Paul was his father's carer for ten years and is a member of Donington Emergency Services Team. He also owns Paul Bysh Valeting Services which has been in business for twenty-eight years.

Donington Park has an annual budget that runs the unit. However, Donington ES Team occasionally receives donations from various sources and its own crew, which allows its members to purchase equipment beyond the minimum required by the MSA. (Motor Sports Association)
