Module	Synopsis	Ranking
Basic Marshalling	An introduction to Marshalling, covering the basic principles, requirements and expectations – ideal for cadets, tasters, all trainees, refreshers	
Fire Theory	Classroom based session on understanding motorsport fire risks, checking equipment and how to use it effectively, knowledge of fire prevention actions and procedures.	
Fire Practical	A Practical session incorporating checking and handling of equipment and extinguishing a car fire safely. (Sorry observation only for Under 18's)	
Communication	An interactive session covering communications with different personnel at a race event, and the different ways of communicating; as well as use of phones and radios.	
Flags	This session covers the theory, actions and examples of good practice to conducting effective flagging when on post, and updates on procedures for Safety Car.	
FMOS Part 1 – Incident Handling	A Theory session covering what to do in the event of an incident, handling drivers and vehicles for recovery, communicating with colleagues on post and track care	
FMOS Part 2 – First Aid	An introductory session covering basic principles on First Aid to assist colleagues and guidelines on what to do whilst waiting for professional assistance.	
Assessment	A session particularly useful for Examining grades on how to evaluate your marshalling team undertaking assessments and provide encouraging critique.	
Observation & Report Writing	Theory based session focusing on the skills required for good report writing and improving observations skills. Includes form filling and stewards experiences.	
Leadership	A module to encourage inspiring leadership and management styles within marshalling and to encourage effective team work and development.	
Specialist	A session dedicated to marshalling practices within Assembly/Paddock, Pit Lane, Start Line and Race Control.
