




How many days have you marshalled this year?

Is there anything else you would like the BMMC North West committee to become involved with on your behalf?

106 positive responses (i.e. no action for committee)

Comments included:

- Concerns over competitor and marshal safety due to the growing trend for clerks not to scramble rescue to incidents e.g. GT incident at Shell, Tiedman Trophy incident at Old Hall.
- Walkways behind the ARMCO barriers need looking at.
- As a Post Chief, I would like to get back to having head sets for radios so we can hear what's going on. There was
 mention of a mentor programme a couple of years ago but I heard nothing since. I have been marshalling 32 years
 and was an IO for 13 years. I am happy to mentor any grade and pass on my experience.
- Whilst flags stored on post is very welcome, a facility to display SC boards on post would be welcome, especially if lone flagging.
- It would be nice if flag holders could be fitted in boxes where we flag from them
- Don't forget the old Rally marshals!
- It would be great if al the PC boxes at Oulton could be weatherproofed to the standards of those used by weekday marshals (Clay Hill. Hill top as examples)
- Making the bank behind the barriers safe to run on as some are dangerous as you could hurt your ankles when you have to move quickly to get to a crashed car as the surface is not level
- More visibility of the specialist roles. The club's marketing and recruitment is too focussed towards track duties and therefore it's difficult to promote and fill the specialist duties and that affects team numbers at quite a lot of meetings. We need to show that marshalling is more than just flags, crashes and cars in gravel traps.
