Well the 2020 training season is upon us. The South Mids Region's training day is on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of February so I hope to see a good number of you there. I know that some of our new members have already attended a Silverstone Marshals Team (SMT) Training day; that is to be expected with a large number of our members also belonging to SMT. You are not expected to attend every training day, but remember that you should attend one every three years to maintain your grade and Motorsport UK registration. Also, you cannot upgrade unless you have completed the requisite number of training days, and we do need people to upgrade. Mentioning training days takes me back to the first ones I attended in the 70s. Things were a bit different then, but not so much that you wouldn't recognise the content. Fire training was considered very important, especially following the deaths of Jo Siffert at Brands and Roger Williamson at Zandvoort. I sat through numerous showings of the fire training film "Thirty Seconds to Live" which introduced the 2 x 2 fire-fighting system. This was based on the premise that a driver trapped in a burning car only had thirty seconds before the fire consumed all oxygen and they suffocated. Back then only the Pit Marshals and the Rescue Unit crews had fire retardant overalls or silver suits. The rest of us relied on wearing clothes made of wool or cotton, natural fibres that were less likely to catch fire. At Brands, where I started marshalling, each post provided a builders hard-hat with a Perspex visor and a flap of canvas at the back to protect your neck as additional protection. They were awful devices that wobbled about as you ran, and when you pulled the visor down you couldn't see anything because of paint spray-back after circuit staff had used them for painting Armco! The medical lectures were very different to todays. There was no first on scene, a little basic First Aid about stopping bleeding and keeping airways clear, but some pretty gory slides showing injuries suffered through not wearing seatbelts! Things were very different in the 70s!

On a different note Congratulations to Bob Sketchley for being awarded the Barrie Williams Trophy, the Clubs national marshal of the year award. On receiving the award Bob said "I don't know what I did differently last year, but thank you." Well Bob I don't know either, I wasn't involved in the selection process, but the award is thoroughly deserved. Bob has been a mainstay of the Club for many years. He recruits the majority of the speakers for our Noggin & Natter evenings; he has organised visits to racing teams and car restorers, and he is reckoned to be one of the most reliable Post Chiefs. The next Noggin & Natter is on 11<sup>th</sup> February in the White Horse PH Silverstone and our guest speaker is Hugh Chambers the CEO of Motorsport UK. Be there to ask him questions or to answer questions he has!

Finally, I will be at the SMT Dinner Dance. With everyone in their best bib & tucker I probably won't recognise you, so say hello and introduce yourself. If you read this after the event, I hope we all had a good time.
