

## Chairman's Chatter

WOW! What a busy month it has been! Only one weekend actually marshalling so far and only a couple of days working at Silverstone. I had to cry off the GT meeting because I had a stinking cold. However still got two days of HSCC to look forward to at the end of the month. So, what has kept me busy? Well, the Governance Working Group (GWG) has been busy putting the final touches together to the revised Club Articles and Rules and this has included defining all regional and national roles for The Board (the Directors), national co-ordinators (previously known as Executive Officers) and regional committees. On the 17<sup>th</sup> the Directors met and reviewed the GWG proposals and agreed that we were in a position to put the changes to the members at an Extra General Meeting. We are currently looking for a suitable date.



The Officers of the Club (National Chairman, Secretary, & Treasurer) invited all North East members to a Zoom meeting to discuss the future of the region following the resignation of the Chairman and eight committee members. Those that were present made it clear they wanted to continue as a region. Nadine said that the Officers are there to help. It was agreed more use of social media should be made and good communications with the membership are key. NW and Midland region have offered to help bring the region together.

Alex Hodgkinson (Chairman SW region) and myself were recruited to interview the candidates for the BMCC National Training Officer post vacated by Lynne Kendall. We had three applications and decided to carry out the interviews over three nights so we could provide a recommendation to the Directors meeting on the 17<sup>th</sup>. Following the interviews Alex and I compared notes and came to the same conclusion; we both felt Cath Holmstrom was the best candidate despite only being a marshal for seven years. In that time she has attended 30-40 race meetings and 5-10 Speed events per year. She was the only candidate currently marshalling at grass roots level as well as national and international races as Post Chief; after all we are British Motorsports Marshals. The other candidates experience was limited to Race/Rally Rescue or Race.

On the 16<sup>th</sup> I attended another Association of British Motor Racing Clubs committee meeting as Secretary and was able to support Mike Broadbent's arguments that marshals should be included in decisions about the location of flag points and light panels. Motorsport UK reported they had reached a decision that flags and lights should be co-located and are arranging this except at Silverstone where FIA permission is required to make changes. Mike asked when would Motorsport UK produce guidance on how the lights should be operated. Motorsport UK stated regulations would be drafted when the BTCC trial was completed. The point was made we need training and guidance now because the lights are not only used at BTCC events. As Motorsport UK said the systems GPS can be used to track competitors and identify overtaking infringements I questioned the accuracy of the GPS. I guess we have all experienced Satnav systems instructing us to turn now some 15/20 feet before a junction; how many car lengths is that?

Finally, on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Tessa and I attended the 750MC meeting at Trac Mon. This was our first visit to the Anglesey circuit! What a GEM! Fantastic old style circuit with virtually no armco or gravel traps, just earth banks. Tessa was working in Race Control logging and entering data into GT Apps. She loved the view across the Menai Strait to Snowdon. The weather was great on Saturday but overcast on Sunday with light rain during the two hour enduro race on Sunday. As it was my first visit to the circuit I volunteered as a Flag marshal but found I was alone flagging and observing – no change there then! We had a great weekend. Everyone was friendly and helpful. We will be back.

# Secretary Scribblings

The South Midlands committee meets monthly, at present on the internet using Zoom, and all members are welcome to join us. Here is a summary of the topics that the committee have covered since the last Newsletter:

- discussed the negative impact on visibility and circuit access for marshals from the creation of a new spectator bank at Brooklands/Luffield, the construction fencing around the new kart circuit, and the extended debris fencing along the Assembly Area. Some areas of the track are no longer visible from some flag posts, whilst the additional fencing is restricting how Incident Marshals get to and from the track. This will be raised with the appropriate bodies.
- started applications to the respective organisers for our recruitment stand at events in 2023, both at Silverstone and at other venues. As we have been promised the loan of some competition cars at some events, we are able to ask for larger stands than in previous years. - heard from our Membership Secretary, Steve, how he is encouraging and supporting potential new marshals to register with Motorsport UK and volunteer for an event, without having a Taster Day first. He has produced a "first-time guide" for marshalling at Silverstone which helps new marshals navigate that all-important first day and get the best from their experience.
- received a report from our first Taster Day at Silverstone for potential new marshals. All four attendees opted to "shadow" Incident Marshals for the afternoon, all had a "taste of the action" on their posts, and all have since joined BMMC *and* marshalled again! - noted that Council have asked for recommendations for the charity that BMMC will support in 2024, we are supporting Race Against Dementia in 2023. If anyone has any suggestions, please send them to Chris at [sm.chair@marshals.co.uk](mailto:sm.chair@marshals.co.uk) and he will forward on.
- noted that North East Region Committee has received a number of resignations, and all the South Midlands Committee members offered to help if required until the roles are filled.
- noted that there was a period in late 2022/early 2023 when Motorsport UK were not notifying a marshal's Primary Club if they were granted a new grade under the Acquired Rights Scheme, so BMMC records would be out of date. If this applies to you please read the relevant article elsewhere in this Newsletter to ensure we have all your latest grading information.

The dates for 2023 are below, all are on a Monday evening and the meeting starts at 19:45.
