### A Woeful Marshal's Tale

Organisers sometimes get strange reasons for marshals no longer being available for meetings but, this one is a brilliant excuse, unless you are the participant.

BMMC South West Regional Membership Secretary Graham Ellis was due to attend Brands Hatch on 10<sup>th</sup> November to hopefully get his incident upgrade. He was on holiday in Spain and was driving back from Spain, through France to Caen and then sailing home on a cross channel ferry.

All was well as he and his wife entered France and headed North, that is until they reached the area around Cahors. Graham's wife, Celia, was driving when hunters chased a wild boar out of the woods into the path of their car. At 80kph (50mph) there was no way to avoid the fast moving animal and a collision occurred. Luckily both Graham and Celia were uninjured but the wild boar was killed and the front of their car was damaged along with the radiator, immobilising the car.



The boar was a young adult, about six foot in length and weighing a significant amount. It was a wonder that it did not do more significant damage to the car and its occupants.

### **New Supplier - Lille Racewear**

For those of you not aware that AWS will no longer be in a position to supply new overalls for marshals, please see the following update:

This is a further update following our communication dated 23<sup>rd</sup> January when we announced Lille Racewear as the new manufacturer and supplier of BMMC proban overalls.

Firstly, we need to confirm that AWS has now ceased taking new orders. Orders placed up to and including 31st January will be manufactured and dispatched during February. There may be a delay on some orders pending receipt of some sponsor badges.

Lille Racewear and AWS have been in contact to ensure a smooth transition. Currently we are just waiting for Lille to finalise their website and, like AWS, they are waiting on delivery of some sponsors badges.

We anticipate Lille will be ready to take orders in a couple of weeks and as soon as everyone is confident that all the final hurdles have been overcome we will issue a final communication giving the green light.

Should there be any other updates I will advise accordingly.
