Summary of National Council Meeting 16th June 2022 7pm

The second National Council Meeting of 2022 was held on 16th June 2022 by Zoom with the following in attendance:

Nadine Lewis (NL), John Edwards (JE), Chris Whitlock (CW), Robert Causey (RC), John Jones (JJ), Jayne Poston (JP) and Bill Gray (BG) on behalf of Michael Broadbent

The minutes of the meeting held on 2nd March 2022 were agreed as a true record; proposed by CW seconded by JP.

The following matters were discussed:

BMMC Self-funding for Training

NL has discussed with MSUK that this become part of Volunteer Officials Committee (VOC), as it is recognised this item has dropped off the agenda recently. VOC will therefore be able to look at all training.

Membership Data Quality and impact on Volunteering

A review of the membership data quality has been carried out and there are still 180 marshals who have no grade against their name. It was agreed that the situation should be monitored for the next couple of months and report issued in September

Disclosure Barring Service

NL advised that as we do not organise the events then the checks should remain with the clubs. NL will cover this matter in next Chair blog

CW advised every training officer has been asked to be DBS checked.

Marshals Pathway

NL advised the consultation was complete, and MSUK have communicated the outcome of the consultation by email to all registered members, including statistics from the responses. MSUK had employed an independent data analyst to review the information, thus picking out the key areas of concern, which have been addressed in the revised pathway. Some clarifications to the Pathway communication were also identified via the data analyst which will be actioned. As a result of this, and evaluation by MSUK, the Marshals Advisory Group have now agreed the format of the revised Pathway, which reflects most of the comments received

Communications are being collated which will be sent out after the Grand Prix, these are being shared with MAG and other interested parties before issue. NL will advise position of revised Pathway in next Chair blog.

Flags and Light Boards

NL has been in communication with MSUK since Donnington BTCC meeting, with a further meeting held at Oulton Park on 13th June 2022. The Lights Working Group will meet to review the feedback received to date. It was confirmed that the purpose of the light panels is to make information to driver clearer, and improve safety, particularly at certain marshal posts at a number of circuits.

MSUK Registration and Training checks

NL advised that these checks on MSUK registration would not be required for 2023, as MSUK have not made this compulsory yet
