Statement of Intent

BMMC recognises its responsibility under current safety and health legislation and believes that incidents are preventable. We will ensure that all appropriate risks under our control are identified and mitigated to an acceptable level.

Policy Aims

To ensure effective implementation of this policy we will:

- Through visible and active leadership, ensure that our members are aware that operating safely is a condition of marshalling;
- Through risk assessment, identify and mitigate to an acceptable level, safety and health hazards in our influence:
- Ensure members are trained to undertake the tasks required;
- Ensure members are empowered to delay or postpone any activity that is considered unsafe;
- Engage with our stakeholders, e.g. racing clubs and circuits to ensure that their safety and health management standards and practices meet or exceed the expectations of this policy;
- Comply with applicable safety and health legislation and the requirements of other standards to which we subscribe;
- Strive for continual improvement in safety and health performance,
- Provide our members with information on occupational health and wellbeing;
- Share this policy with our members, stakeholders, and members of the public;

BMMC National Council will review this policy annually, or following a major regulatory change

This policy will be communicated to all our member's and organisations working on our behalf, on our external website, and made available to third parties.
