Environment and Sustainability Policy

This policy applies to everyone involved in any way with the British Motorsports Marshals Club (BMMC), irrespective of role or capacity. The policy is effective from the Date of Issue shown at the bottom of this page.

## Statement of Intent

BMMC is committed to achieving excellent environmental and sustainability performance, reducing its carbon footprint and being environmentally responsible. As an organisation with direct links to motorsport, the Club recognises the challenges created by the sport it supports.

This policy focuses on BMMC operations, as in general the BMMC does not control motorsport events or race meetings run by other entities. BMMC encourages its members to support Environmental and Sustainability initiatives of other motorsport bodies e.g. FIA, Motorsport UK, event organisers and venues.

## Policy Aims

To ensure effective implementation of this policy we will:

- Follow all relevant environmental regulations.
- Identify and manage areas where BMMC can impact the environment.
- Regularly communicate with members and stakeholders about environmental issues.
- Consider environmental and sustainability factors when procuring services.
- Support lower carbon activities within motorsport including car sharing, public transport options and Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations at race events.

BMMC will review this policy annually, as well as following a major regulatory change.

This policy will be communicated to all our members and organisations working on our behalf, on our external website, and made available to third parties upon request.

## Leadership Responsibilities

The Policy Owner, shown at the bottom of this page, is responsible for implementing this policy on behalf of the BMMC Directors who will monitor its effectiveness.

## Support for Environmental Charities

Regional Committees will identify an appropriate charity to receive an annual donation. The amount of the donation will be determined by the board on an annual basis. This charity should be:

- Based within the region and registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales, Charity Commission for Northern Ireland (or on the deemed list), or the Scottish Charity Regulator.
- Focussed on delivering environmental, sustainability, biodiversity or wildlife activities within their key objectives.
- Not be the subject of a conflict of interest for any Regional Committee member or the Board.

The BMMC Board will set goals for improving our environmental impact annually.
